DISASTER RELIEF ASSISTANCE FOR IMMIGRANTS (DRAI)

The Disaster Relief Assistance for Immigrants (DRAI) program provides state-funded, one-time assistance for undocumented immigrants affected by COVID-19. Adult immigrants who qualify can receive \$500 each in direct assistance, with a maximum of \$1,000 per household.

WHEN WILL THE PROGRAM BEGIN?

Starting on Monday, May 18 at 9:00 a.m., if you are eligible to apply, you can seek help from the nonprofit organization assigned to the county where you live. (See list included)

You can only receive DRAI application assistance from the organizations assigned to your county or region. The organization will help you fill out an application and confirm your eligibility.

Applicants will be considered on a first come, first served basis until funds run out.

ELIGIBILITY

To apply, you must prove that:

- 1. You are an undocumented adult (over the age of 18)
- 2. You are not eligible for federal COVID-19 related assistance, like CARES Act tax stimulus payments or pandemic unemployment benefits
- 3. You have experienced hardship because of COVID-19

Provide information/documents to verify:

- 1. Your identity (CA ID, VISA, Passport, Consular Registration, school/work ID) (expired ID's are accepted)
- Proof of address (utility bill, school enrollment, any governmental letter with name/address, ID which includes address)
 People experiencing homelessness can provide a letter from a shelter.
 Recently released detainees can provide documentation from ICE.
- How you have been affected by COVID-19 Reduced or loss of employment, at home learning, caretaker of COVID-19 patient, or sick from COVID-19
